Important Crossover Notes

Approval

Under the provisions of Schedule 9.1, Clause 7 of the Local Government Act 1995 and Regulation 12, 13 and 15 of the Local Government (Uniform Local Provisions) Regulations 1996, all landowners within the Shire of Mingenew must make application to the Shire to construct a vehicle crossover. Written approval by the Shire of Mingenew **must** be obtained prior to construction of a new/additional crossover.

Council Contribution

If it is the first vehicle crossing constructed to the premises, the Shire of Mingenew may contribute 50% towards the construction cost of a crossover after construction is complete. The contribution is calculated on a **standard 3.0 metre wide crossover**.

To claim a Council contribution all receipts for the labour and materials **must** be itemised and submitted to the Shire within six (6) months from the date that the crossover was constructed.
